### Container

# Liquids



- Blood tubes (including from chemotherapy)
- Smaller sealed containers of blood

- · Collect in sturdy plastic bottle with lid. Do not alter container opening for tube size.
- EHS provides labels.
- Submit for EHS Pickup within 90 days










#### Larger volumes


- blood

- cell line waste








Chemically disinfect then discharge to sewer












- Trauma surgery fluids

Items that are contaminated with:

- potentially infectious materials
- recombinant DNA material



Collect in autoclavable biohazard bags. After autoclaving place in black bag then dumpster.

If no autoclave submit EHS waste request
